



The Assumption and the Queenship of Mary

August contains two special days to honor the Blessed Mother -- the Assumption and the Queenship of Mary. At the end of Mary's earthly life, she was assumed into heaven and upon entering she became Queen of Heaven.

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith:

"We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory."

The pope proclaimed this dogma only after a broad consultation of bishops, theologians and laity. There were few dissenting voices. What the pope solemnly declared was already a common belief in the Catholic Church.

Pope Pius XII established the feast of the Queenship of Mary in 1954, originally celebrated on May 31. The revision in 1969 of the General Roman Calendar

moved it to the eighth or octave day of the solemnity of the Assumption to stress the connectedness of the Blessed Virgin Mary's Assumption and Queenship.

Mary's queenship has roots in Scripture. At the

Annunciation, Gabriel announced that Mary's Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. At the Visitation, Elizabeth calls Mary "mother of my Lord." As in all the mysteries of Mary's life, she is closely associated with

Jesus: Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship.

We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court.

In the fourth century St. Ephrem called Mary "Lady" and "Queen." Later Church fathers and doctors continued to use the title. Hymns of the 11th to 13th centuries address Mary as queen: "Hail, Holy Queen," "Hail, Queen of Heaven," "Queen of Heaven." The Dominican rosary and the Franciscan crown as well as numerous invocations in Mary's litany celebrate her queenship.

The feast is a logical follow-up to the Assumption, and is now celebrated on the octave day of that feast.

In his 1954 encyclical *To the Queen of Heaven*, Pius XII points out that Mary deserves the title because she is Mother of God, because she is closely associated as the New Eve with Jesus' redemptive work, because of her preeminent perfection, and because of her intercessory power.



The Church celebrates the Assumption of Mary on Aug. 15 (a Holy Day of Obligation) and the Queenship of Mary on Aug. 22.

win; that souls could be saved and have eternal life. My apostles, my children, my Son told you to love one another. May this be inscribed in your hearts and with prayer, try to live that love. Thank you!”
