The beautiful gift of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus

The month of July is dedicated to the MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST and we, the faithful, are invited to take the time this month to joyfully recall this most beautiful gift of Our Savior to His Church. When first instituted for the universal Church by Pope Pius IX in 1849, this Feast was observed on the First Sunday of July.

Never is it our intent to separate one particular aspect of Our Master from another, yet we can gain deeper love and gratitude for what those particular things mean in the totality of our devotion to Him. We meditate upon the Nativity of Jesus, His Most Precious Wounds, and so on. To do so, and in this instance we speak of His Precious Blood, we can look to the Cross and gain devotional humility.

His Precious Blood flowing from the piercing of His Side, gushing forth with Water, has from that day been visible as sacred symbols of Holy Baptism and Holy Eucharist. And it is through this sacramental life that we are sustained to eternal life! We live in a world that is a

drunken world of power, materialism, self-service and self-absorbed. Where are we to turn, where are we to go?

I would suggest we follow the guidance of the great hymn-prayer of the 14th century, THE ANIMA CHRISTI, as a remedy. Indeed, if we seek to be “drunk” of any power, let it be the Power of the Precious

Blood of Jesus: “Blood of Christ, inebriate me...”!
