## Group of 13 Radio Maria pilgrims enjoy 9-day trip to Holy Land

A group of thirteen pilgrims recently toured the Holy Land under the direction of Father Emilio Garreaud, priest director of Radio Maria.

One of the pilgrims, Kent Hare, a professor of Early European History at Northwestern State University in Natchitoches, La, wrote a detailed and interesting blog about the pilgrimage at [theprofstravels.blogspot.com](http://theprofstravels.blogspot.com). For a complete account of the trip, visit his blog.

According to Hare, the group hit most of the highlights of a visit to the Holy Land -- the birthplaces of John the Baptist and Mary, as well as the site of the Annunciation; the Church of the Nativity where Jesus was born, the places where Jesus lived, performed miracles, and preached to the crowds; a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee; and following Christ's passion in the Garden of Gethsemane, the Via Dolorosa,

Calvary, and the Tomb of Jesus; and saw many other places.

In his blog, Hare reiterates the profound realization of what Father Emilio pointed out at each sacred place, "It was here, in this place. . ."

Hare said, "I touched holy spots -- each of which had its own profoundly wondrous appeal just from the knowledge that I was seeing -- touching -- places where heaven had in one way or another come down to touch the earth."

The best of the trip for Hare, although very difficult to narrow down, was the Noon Angelus Procession by the Franciscans at the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth.

"I heard them come out chanting Ave Maris Stella (I believe) and for the next ten minutes or so I was in hog heaven," said Hare.

On a final note, Hare said that, contrary to expectations, at no point during the trip did he, or any member of the group, ever feel unsafe in Israel.

"By and large the impression I got was of a peaceful country in which the people went about their daily lives with a feeling of security."

He added, however, that Christians in increasingly-Muslim Palestinian territories, including Bethlehem, depend on pilgrims for their livelihood, and urges all readers to support them by prayer and pilgrimage.

Another pilgrim, Maria Biancavilla, concluded by saying, "I would like to give a special to thank you to Father Emilio for his boundless spiritual direction during our pilgrimage, by lifting us up in prayer, bringing us closer to the Lord and his Blessed Mother and uniting us as a Radio Maria family.

**Sr Emmanuel urges prayer adoration, reparation for recent abuse scandal**

In the face of the new sexual abuse scandals in the Church, it is of course necessary for us to open our eyes and fight by every means to prevent these horrific crimes against children. Let us nevertheless remain centered on Christ and his peace, and never forget that Jesus died because of our crimes, these and all of our own. To fight effectively against these realities that Satan is using to undermine the Church from inside, there is something all Christians can do: prayer, adoration, contemplating Jesus in his Passion, fasting, and lastly - making reparation. Of course, the idea of making reparation might not be very fashionable today, but it is very

pleasing to God, as the saints teach us, so let us begin to make reparation! There are 1000 ways to do it, and you will know in prayer what the Holy Spirit will inspire you to do. However, here are some examples that could guide your choice:

- Have a Mass celebrated to free a priest from purgatory.
- Offer a day of fasting for the priests in Pennsylvania who are impacted by the recent scandals.
- Offer a Way of the Cross for seminarians who are exposed to the dangers of sexual deviations.
- Offer a Rosary to help priests who are in the midst of a crushing spiritual struggle.
- Offer a Mass for children who have been sexually abused by a member of the clergy or his or her family.
- Offer a Mass in honor of the Immaculate Conception and her intentions.
- Renounce any compromise in the field of impurity, starting with pornography, indecent or borderline clothing, any inappropriate words, etc.
