She is asking us to witness our faith in the colors of spring. To me, this means she is calling us to witness NOW as spring is upon us; and the colors of spring are colors of tremendous vibrancy.

So we must witness with great boldness and vigor. It is not a time of timidity. This call of our Mother to witness reminds me of a wonderful quote of St. Paul to Timothy (who on occasion suffered from a

spirit of timidity),

“Preach the word, be urgent in season and out of season, convince, rebuke, and exhort, be unfailing in patience and in teaching. For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own likings, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander into myths. As for you, always be steady, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfil your ministry.” (2 Tim. 4:2-5)

This Word is for us in this time. By virtue of our baptism, we are all called to evangelize the world; to bring everyone to Jesus. And the fastest way to Jesus is through Mary.

Our Lady is basically paraphrasing St. Paul’s call to witness. We must also realize that the word martyr comes from the Greek word to “witness” to the faith. So we must be 100% aligned with Jesus, giving glory to The Father, in the power of the Spirit, to witness properly.

And Mother Mary in this message promises us that she is placing us in her Immaculate Heart and accompanying us on this journey of holiness to witness to our faith. What a wonderful promise!

We are so blessed to be alive in these exciting times, and to have Our Lady present to us in her apparitions, always drawing us to her Son, Jesus. Let us spend May coming closer to Jesus, Mary and Joseph and to give a great witness of the love of God.

Ten ways to celebrate May, the month of Mary

May is the month of Mary. Mary is the daughter of God the Father, the Mother of God the Son and the Mystical Spouse of the Holy Spirit, the Queen of the angels, saints, of heaven and earth. St. Louis de Montfort acclaims her as the Queen of all hearts and God's masterpiece of creation.

Here are some ways that we can manifest our love and devotion to Our Blessed Mother:

1. Consecration -- The first gesture we should do every morning is prayer — a prayer of consecration to Jesus through the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

St. Mother Teresa moved by great love for Mary said:

"Mary, give me your heart: so beautiful, so pure, so immaculate; your Heart so full of love and humility that I may be able to receive Jesus in the Bread of Life and love Him as you love Him and serve Him in the distressing guise of the poor."

2. Angelus/Regina Caeli. Traditionally this prayer is prayed at noon, but it can be prayed at any time. Why not pray it three times a day — at 9:00 am, 12 noon, and 6:00 pm. By doing this we will be sanctifying the morning hours, the afternoon hours, and the evening



hours through the holy and sweet presence of Mary.

3. Consecrate the Home and Family to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. -- Prepare for the consecration by a nine-day novena of Rosaries and prayers and culminate with the priest blessing the image as well as the home and family members. From this blessing and consecration, God the Father will shower a deluge of blessings upon you and every member in your family.

4. Consecration of the Self -- Go through the formal process of consecration of your whole being to Jesus through Mary. You can choose various forms: Kolbe, or St. Louis de Montfort, or the modern one done by Father Michael Gaiety — *33 Days to Morning Glory*. This consecration could change dramatically your whole life.

5. Imitate Mary -- If we truly love somebody, then we want to get to know them better, follow them

more closely and finally to imitate their good qualities that we call virtues. St. Louis de Montfort in his classic *True Devotion to Mary* gives us a list of the ten principal virtues of Mary:

Her deep humility,
lively faith,
blind obedience,
unceasing prayer,
constant self-denial,
surpassing purity,
ardent love,
heroic patience,
angelic kindness,
and heavenly wisdom!

6. Temptations? Call on Mary -- Our life is a constant combat zone, until death! We should not fight alone against the devil, the flesh and the world. Rather, in the heat of temptation, when all seems to be lost, call upon the Holy Name of Mary; pray the Hail Mary!

7. Mary and the Liturgical Year. -- Mary has a special place in the liturgical year.

Mary is the Mother of God, the Mother of the Church and she is our Mother in the order of grace! Read and meditate attentively the Apostolic Letter of Pope

Paul VI *Marialis Cultus*, which clearly explains the presence of Mary in the liturgical calendar.

8. Learn about Mary -- For a well-formed and integral Mariology, we should cultivate both doctrine and devotion. Why not read the Apostolic Letter of St. Pope John Paul II *Blessed Virgin Mary and the Rosary*. Or listen to the following Marian programs on Radio Maria: *Mary, Queen of Peace*, hosted by Fr. John Fletcher

Marian Apparitions, hosted by Mary Pyper, Wednesdays, 10 a.m.

The School of Mary, hosted by Depalma, Thursdays at 10 a.m.

Marian Studies and Spirituality, Marian Library at UD

Mary, Mother and Queen of the Divine Will, hosted by Cynthia Zack, Laura Riccardi and Br. Nickolas Ricardi

9. Marian Apostle -- Become an ardent and fervent and passionate Apostle of Mary. One of the most famous modern Marian saints is St. Maximilian Kolbe. Try becoming a modern Marian apostle today, following in the footsteps of Kolbe.

10. The Most Holy Rosary -- In each and every apparition, Our Lady of Fatima insisted upon the praying of the most Holy Rosary. Pray the Rosary and pray it daily!

Radio Maria was born as a parish radio in 1983 in the Diocese of Milan, Italy. Its purpose was to keep parishioners informed and to help them through prayer, the daily Mass and the Rosary. But it quickly grew in popularity into other countries. Radio Maria began broadcasting from its first English-speaking station in the US on May 25, 2000 in Alexandria, La. It has since expanded to include 11 frequencies in six other states.
