## The Church celebrates the birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Sept. 8

The Catholic Church celebrates the birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary on its traditional fixed date of Sept. 8, nine months after the Dec. 8 celebration of her Immaculate Conception as the child of Saints Joachim and Anne.

The circumstances of the Virgin Mary’s birth are not recorded in the Bible, but are cited by some of the earliest Christian writers from the first centuries of the Church.

These accounts, although not considered authoritative in the same manner as the Bible, outline some of the Church’s traditional beliefs about the birth of Mary.

The *Protoevangelium of James*, which was probably put into its final written form in the early second century, describes Mary’s father Joachim as a wealthy member of one of the Twelve Tribes of Israel. Joachim was deeply grieved, along with his wife Anne, by their childlessness. Joachim and Anne began to devote themselves extensively and rigorously to prayer

and fasting, initially wondering whether their inability to conceive a child might signify God’s displeasure with them.

An angel revealed to Anne when he appeared to her and prophesied that all generations would honor their future child: “The Lord has heard your prayer, and you shall conceive, and shall bring forth, and your seed shall be spoken of in all the world.”

After Mary’s birth, according to the *Protoevangelium*, Anne “made

a sanctuary” in the infant girl’s room, and “allowed nothing common or unclean” on account of the special holiness of the child. The same writing records that when she was one year old, her father “made a great feast, and invited the priests, and the scribes, and the elders, and all the people of Israel.”

Joachim brought the child to the priests and they blessed her, saying: “Give her an everlasting name to be named in all generations.”



# American Needs Fatima heads protest of vulgar play about Mary

*The Testament of Mary* is a blasphemous play attacking the purity and doctrinal fidelity of the Blessed Mary. It has already been playing at the Arl Cherry Center for Arts in Carmel by the Sea, California since Aug. 18, 2022 but the Catholic organization America Needs Fatima (ANF) is protesting its showing and hopes to shut it down before it ends on Sept. 11, 2022.

The 90-minute one-man show, starring Fiona Shaw, was shown before on Broadway in 2013; but the protests of ANF both online and on-site, helped to shut it down 6-weeks before its scheduled end.

In 2014 it was picked up by a San Francisco theatre and again ANF defended Our Blessed Mother and the Mother of God's purity of body and doctrine online and on-site. Many theatergoers turned away.

Some of the blasphemies depicted previously on stage include:

- Stripping most pure Mary completely naked on stage, as was done in NYC on Broadway in 2014.
- Denying Jesus to be the Son of God.
- Saying "I am not one of his followers."
- Calling the apostles "a group of misfits." Not one of them "normal."

- Fleeing the Crucifixion, saying: "It was my own safety I thought of; it was to protect myself."

ANF director Robert E. Ritchie is once again heading a campaign to protest the show. He is asking people to sign a Petition of Protest, that will be sent directly to the Carl Cherry Center for the Arts in Carmel of the Sea, Calif.

"This play is nothing but pure perversity and blasphemy," said Ritchie. "No Christian of good will can remain indifferent to such offenses. Furthermore, the Virgin Mary, as portrayed in the play, is a vulgar, egoistic unbeliever. This play is an insult to the Blessed

Mother—a terrible sacrilege.

"That is why I am urging you to join with America Needs Fatima and all other God-fearing Americans to reject it—always legally and peacefully.

"You can do this by offering your prayers and reparation for the offense it gives to Almighty God, Mary Most Holy, and the Catholic Church—Christ's Mystical Body or by signing an online Petition of Protest."

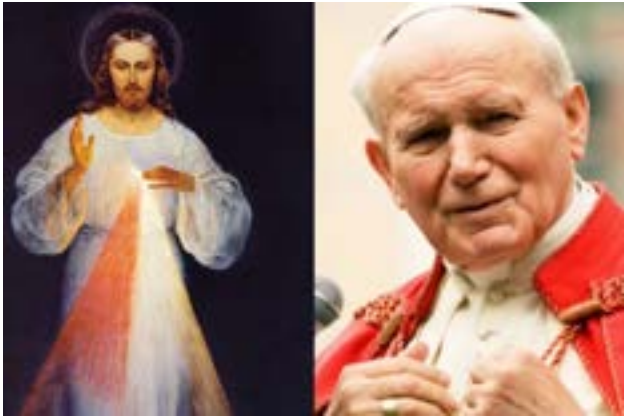
First fostered in Spain in 1513, then invoked against the Turks at Vienna on Sept. 12, 1683, this devotion to Mary inspired King John Sobieski of Poland to put the misbelievers to flight, and thus to save Christendom from devastation.

Pope Innocent XI extended observance of the feast to the whole church on Nov. 25, 1683.

The name of Mary was chosen by the Most High for the fairest of the daughters of Eve, the mother of His Divine Son, and was revealed to Anne and Joachim by the angel Gabriel who was later to announce to their child the great privilege accorded her by God.

On Aug. 17, 2002, twenty years ago, Pope John Paul II entrusted the world to Divine Mercy as he consecrated the International Shrine of The Divine Mercy in Lagiewniki, Poland.

Standing before the image of Divine Mercy, the pope said, “I wish solemnly to entrust the world to Divine Mercy. I do so with the burning desire that the message of God’s merciful love, proclaimed here through Saint Faustina, may be made known to all the peoples of the earth and fill their hearts with hope.”

He finished his homily with this prayer:

### Prayer of Entrustment of the World to Divine Mercy

God, merciful Father,  
 in your Son, Jesus Christ,  
 you have revealed your love and poured it out  
 upon us in the Holy Spirit, the Comforter,  
 We entrust to you today the destiny of the world  
 and of every man and woman.  
 Bend down to us sinners,  
 heal our weakness,  
 conquer all evil,  
 and grant that all the peoples of the earth  
 may experience your mercy.  
 In You, the Triune God,  
 may they ever find the source of hope.  
 Eternal Father,  
 by the Passion and Resurrection of your Son,  
 have mercy on us and upon the whole world!

# 'The Atlantic' publishes article on the rosary as symbol of far-right, violent extremism

An article published Aug. 14 in *The Atlantic* magazine suggests the rosary has become a symbol of violent, right-wing extremism in the United States.

The article set off a frenzy of reactions among Catholics, ranging from amusement to grave concern over what some see as anti-Catholic sentiment.

"The rosary has acquired a militaristic meaning for radical-traditional (or "rad trad") Catholics," writes Daniel Panneton of the sacramental used in prayer by Catholics for centuries.

"Militia culture, a fetishism of Western civilization, and masculinist anxieties have become mainstays of the far right in the U.S.—and rad-trad Catholics have now taken up residence in this company," writes Panneton, whose article includes three links to Roman Catholic Gear, an online shop that sells rosaries.

## The Catholic reaction

Asked to comment on the article, Robert P. George, professor of political theory at Princeton University and former chairman of the United States Commission on International Religious Free-



dom (USCIRF), told CNA:

"It looks to me like the guy who is politicizing the rosary and treating it as a weapon in the culture war is ... Daniel Panneton. I know nothing about the guy other than what he says in the article. I hadn't heard of him before. Although it's hard to miss the classic anti-Catholic tropes in the piece, perhaps he isn't actually a bigot. Maybe he just overwrought and needs to take an aspirin or two and lie down for a while."

Fr. Pius Pietrzyk, OP, a Dominican priest of the Province of St. Joseph, told CNA, "The article is a long-running stream of inaccuracies, logical fallacies, and distortions."

The author, he said, fails to understand that "the notion of 'spiritual combat' has been with the Church from time imme-

morial. Recall that a traditional view of Confirmation is that it made one a 'soldier for Christ.'"

"The problem is that The Atlantic does not seem to understand what metaphor means. In no wise, does the notion of rosary as 'combat' imply physical violence," Pietrzyk added.

On Twitter, Fr. Aquinas Guilbeau, OP, responded to the article with a photo of white-robed two friars wearing their traditional rosary beads around their waists. "WARNING: The image below contains rosaries," read the caption.

Novelist and essayist Walter Kirn commented that The Atlantic article itself serves as an example of "extremism."

Eduard Habsburg, Hungary's Ambassador to the Holy See, responded by conceding the rosary

is indeed a weapon — used for centuries against evil. He Tweeted: "There is one entity that REALLY REALLY has a problem with the rosary. And trust me, you don't want to be on his team."

## The rosary, a "weapon" of choice for centuries

The rosary, first promoted by the Dominican Order by the 16th century, is a form of prayer based on meditations on the life of Christ. The beads are a tool to help keep track of prayers that are recited before and the meditations.

Since 1571, popes have urged Catholics to pray the rosary. In doing so they have often employed military terms for these prayer "weapons." In 1893, Pope Leo XIII saw the rosary as an antidote to the evils of inequality born of the Industrial Revolution, and during World War II Pius XI urged the faithful to pray it in hopes that "the enemies of the divine name (...) may be finally bent and led to penance and return to the straight path, trusting to the care and protection of Mary."

More recently, Pope St. John Paul II, Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis have recommended the rosary as a powerful spiritual tool.
